Safety Protocols for Wostawea Programs

The program leader will review Wostawea Safety Procedures with their coaches. In the event of an emergency, the coach will:

- 1. Call 9-1-1.
- 2. Secure the safety of the scene.
- 3. Contact group leader who will direct first responders to the scene.
- 4. Provide for a guide to meet emergency services at the trail head, to direct or escort first responders to the scene.
- 5. Remain with, and provide comfort to, the injured skier until emergency services arrives, or the injured skier (or legal guardian if applicable) chooses no further assistance from Wostawea or emergency services.
- 6. Complete an Incident Report Form and notify the Wostawea president as soon as possible and within 24 hours of occurrence.
